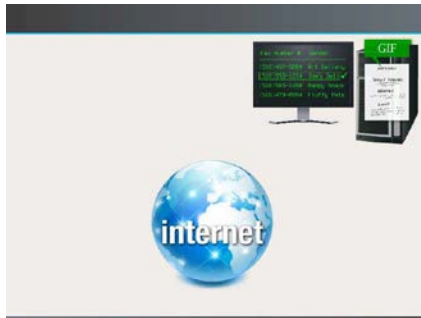


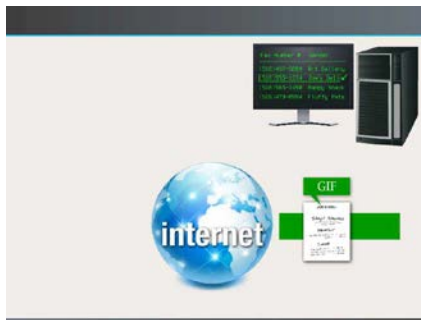
Defendants' Mediation Brief Exhibit A – Faxing to the Internet

The plaintiff's invention is more limited than plaintiff asserts. The patent shows the inventor had at most "invented" the following well-known techniques:

1. Receiving a facsimile and checking it against a database for identification as illustrated below (see patent at 1:42-2:15) :
